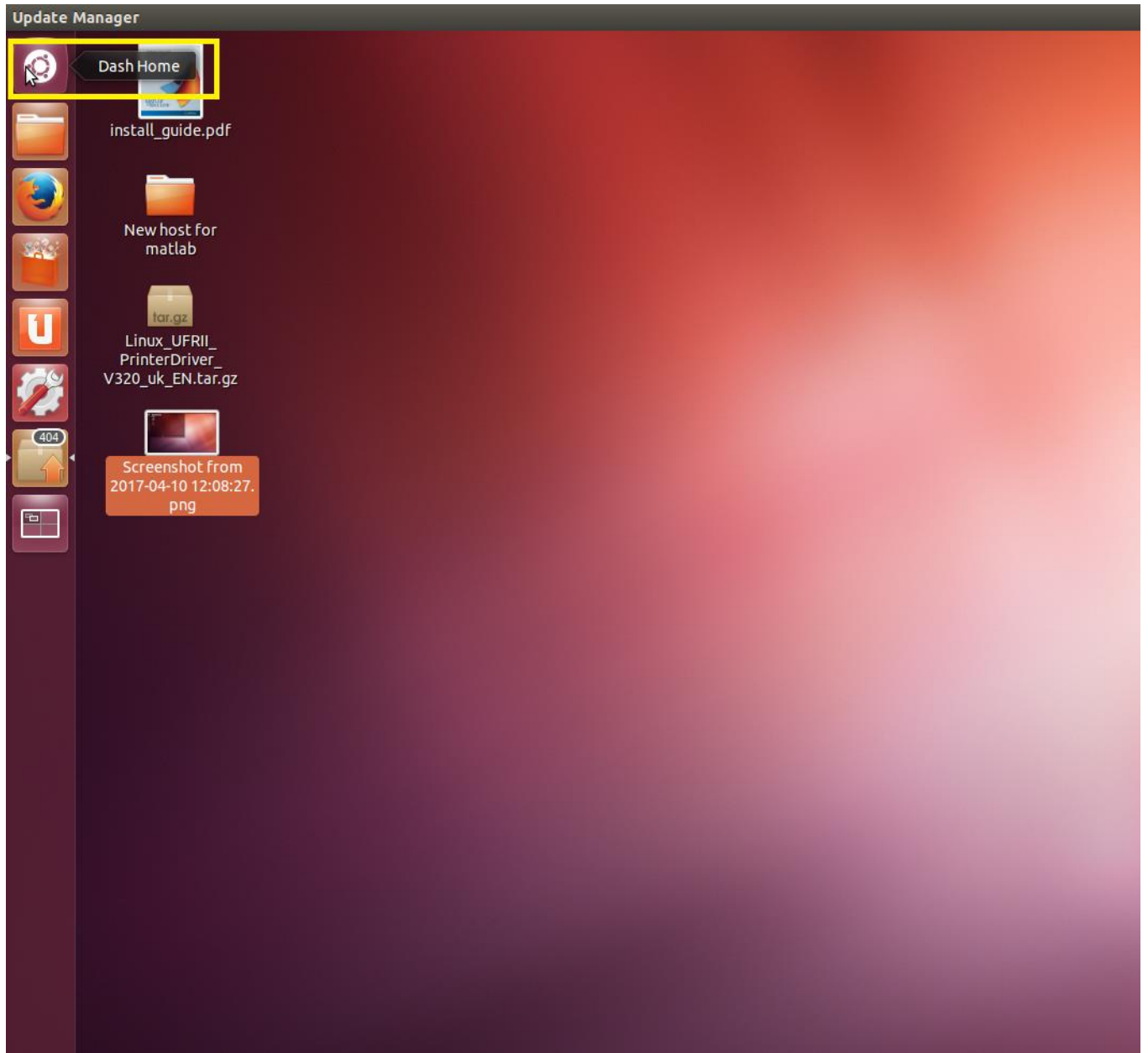
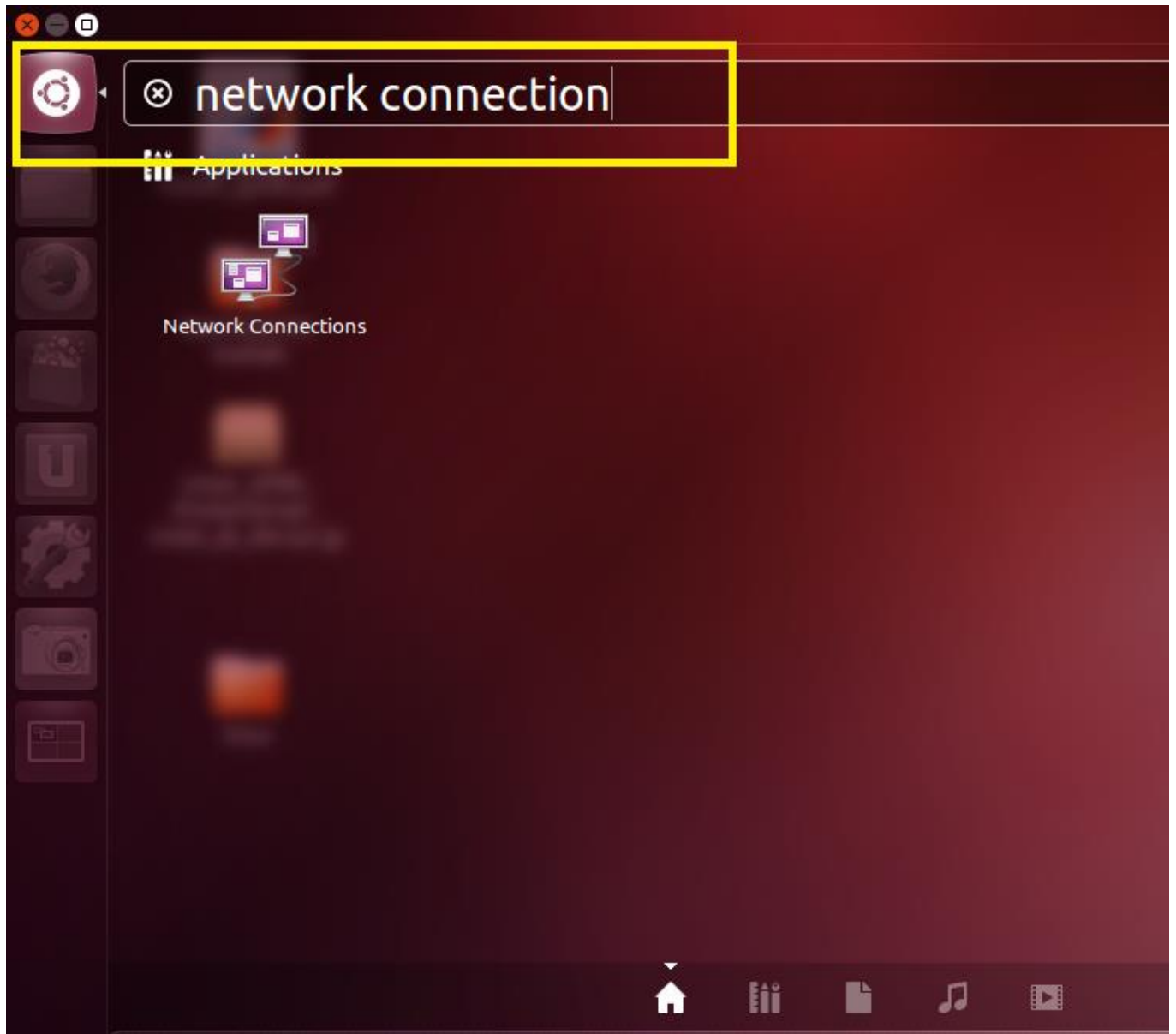

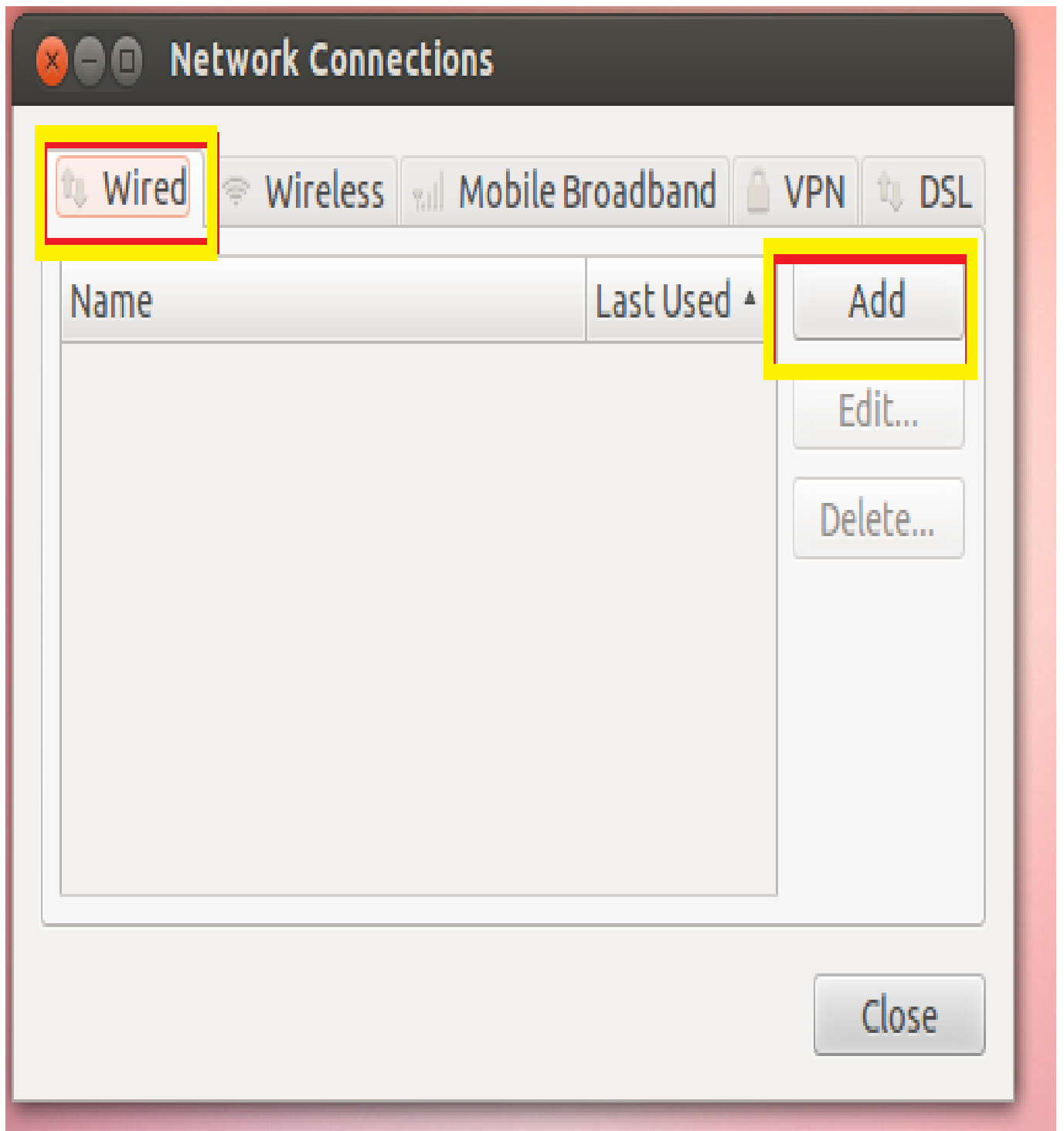
Click on Dash Home.



Type Network connection.



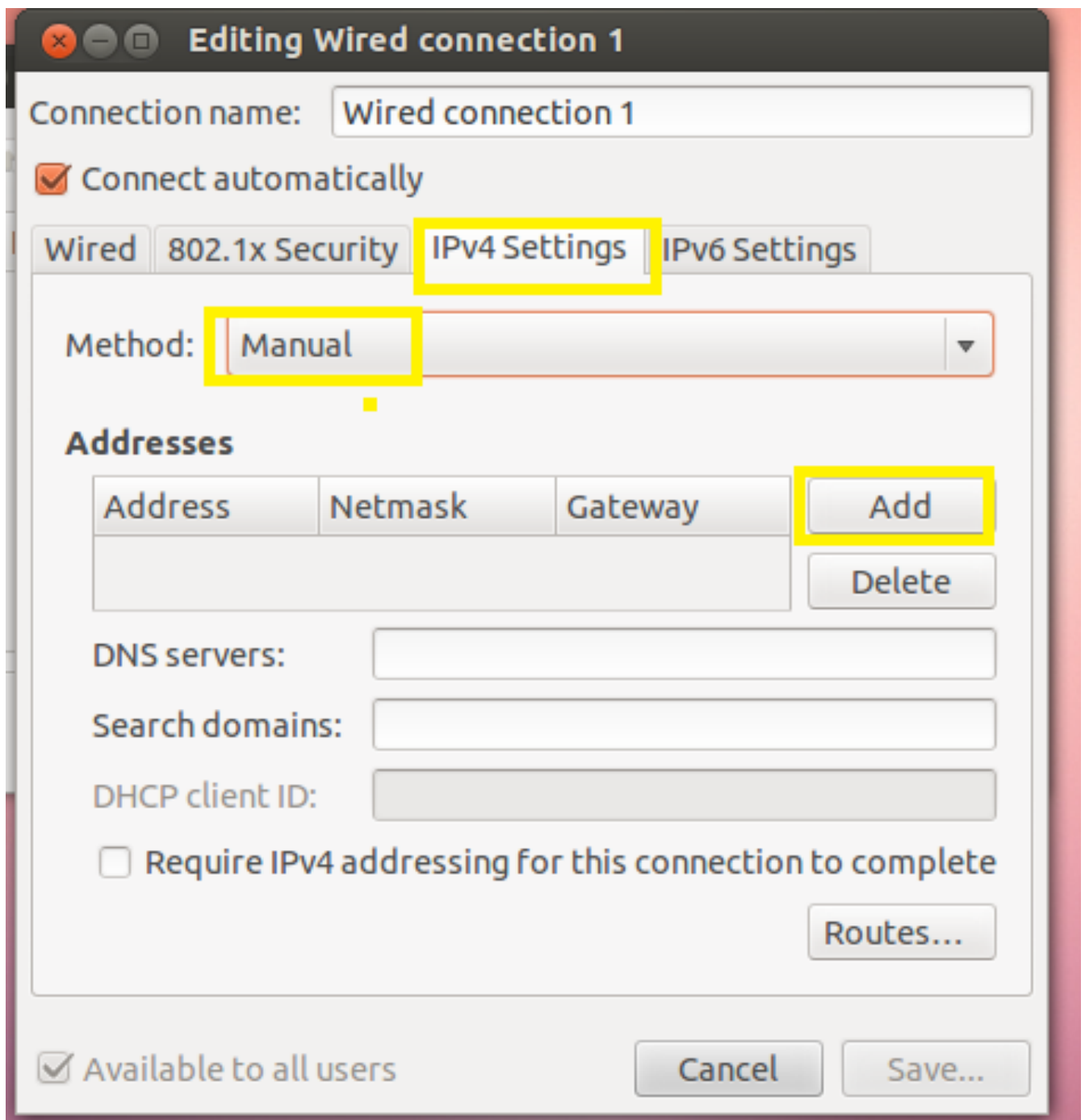
Click on wired than click on Add.
